

## SUGGESTED POLICY ON NAMING OF CUPS

The main national cups and trophies presented annually on behalf of Ard Chomhairle are listed below.

It should be noted that a number of the existing trophies do not have a name.

The following policy is suggested by the CCCC in relation to the naming of Cups:

1. Where it is agreed by Ard Chomhairle to create a new competition, Counties will be asked to propose names for same. The C.C.C.C will compile a list and make a recommendation to An Coiste Bainistíochta based on the names submitted
2. If Ard Chomhairle itself decides it is appropriate to place a name on an existing Cup/Trophy, Counties will be asked to propose names for same. If being named after a person, the person must be deceased, must have been a member of the GAA and should ideally have an obvious connection to the relevant competition
3. For Cups that do not already have a name, and where a unit of the Association applies to name a cup in someone's memory the following shall apply;
  - a. The unit proposing to name the cup must be prepared to supply a new trophy/cup
  - b. The new trophy/cup must be of equivalent or greater value to the existing trophy/cup
  - c. The person after whom the trophy/cup is to be named must be deceased, must have been a member of the GAA and ideally should have an obvious connection to the relevant competition.
  - d. Proposals meeting the above requirements will be circulated to all Counties and they will be given a month to provide observations on the appropriateness of the particular re-naming.
  - e. The C.C.C.C will make a final recommendation to An Coiste Bainistíochta on the matter, for the ultimate approval of Ard Chomhairle.
