Important information for players / officials

- This is a free service provided to players by the GAA
- All players / officials must have their accreditation to access the bus
- > The bus will be available in the morning to take teams to Owenbeg and afternoon to provide a return journey.
- ➤ We recommend players get on a bus 1 hour 30 minutes before their first game
- The schedule is strict to ensure all games occur, if teams are not ready on time, the game will be forfeited as per world games charter.

Derry City Bus Route (Guildhall and Magee)

The Derry City Bus Route in Guildhall and Magee will start at 7.25 each morning and run every 30 minutes until 9.30am. The 9.30am bus will be the last bus to Owenbeg Centre of Excellence each day on this route.

Derry Players should aim to get a bus a minimum of 1hr 30 minutes before their first game. The bus will take approximately 30 minutes to reach Owenbeg from Derry City. The bus scheduled has been designed to accommodate teams on this basis. As the shuttle bus service will make stops on the way, please allow time for your journey to Owenbeg.

Derry City Route (Ebrington)

The Ebrington Bus Stop will start at 7.30 have pick up points in the Waterfoot Hotel, Premier Inn and Belfry Hotel.
