Central Fixtures Oversight Committee (CFOC) formation

As we move towards One Association for Gaelic Games by 2027, the topic of fixtures has been a key feature in the ongoing work on Integration which began in 2023.

At the most recent meeting with members of the Steering Group on Integration (SGI), it was agreed that a newly created Central Fixtures Oversight Committee (CFOC) would be established. The purpose of this group would be to take a wide-angle view of fixtures across the three associations with a long-term vision for fixtures in one association. There is also a requirement for a high-level vision towards integrated fixtures which would see the development of a protocol around the provision of facilities across all codes, in one association.

The development of this group is seen as a significant step towards full integration of Camogie, GAA & LGFA and a fixtures programme for all.

Terms of reference for the group were agreed upon at the most recent SGI meeting and work will begin over the coming months.
