Non-Compliance with Disciplinary Rules

Rules involved:

Rule 7.1 – Disciplinary Jurisdiction of respective Committees

Rule 3.41(a) A/C Supreme Governing Body.

Rule 3.41(b) A/C Issue Guidelines/Directives to assist with compliance with Rule.

Rule 3.41(e) A/C Jurisdiction extends over the whole Association in all matters

Rule 3.41(g) A/C decisions on all matters are final and binding on all members

Rule 3.45(e) CCCC Authority to direct Enforcement.

Rules 3.18(iv) Co. Hearings Committee and Rule 3.30(iii) – Provincial Hearings Committee.

Reports of Non-Compliance.

- Where Reports are made, especially where there is a trend in non-compliance, the CCCC to investigate and examine full file and evidence presented.
- If CCCC is satisfied that there is non-compliance with the Disciplinary Rules, it should issue a Directive to comply with the Enforcement of the Rules, and advise that continuing non-compliant will lead to the Committee itself being subject to a Disciplinary Process.
- Where there is evidence of continuing non-compliant, Disciplinary Action be taken against the Committee Under Rule 7.3(e) – Misconduct Considered to have Discredited the Association.
- The CCCC may not alter the Decision taken in an individual case or direct that it be altered.
