


Select 'Seating Groups' from the side-menu.



Enter your Seating Group name and then select the product you wish it to apply for

Then Click on Create Seating Group

To invite someone to join your Seating Group, you will need to know their Season Ticket Account ID and the email used for that Season Ticket Account.

Your friend must also have the same product – so if you have a Cork Football Season Ticket you cannot form a Seating Group with someone with just a Cork Hurling Season Ticket or with just a Kerry Football Season Ticket.

The Season Ticket Account ID and email appears in the top left-hand corner of the screen – so you can ask your friends to check there if required.

Enter the Account ID and the email and click Send Now.
