

Ulster GAA Student Bursary Scheme Eligibility Criteria

Ulster GAA welcomes applications from those students from our province regardless whether their attendance is at a college inside or outside of Ulster.

Applicants must:

- be attending a full time undergraduate course at a University or third level College;
- be eligible, under Comhairle Ardoideachais Constitution and Bye Laws, to play in Higher Education GAA Competitions;
- be in their second year of study, or above, i.e. 'freshers' are ineligible to apply;
- not be in receipt of any other Bursary/Scholarship or Sports Academy Scholarships, where they are in receipt of 'in kind' benefits;
- be actively involved in their Higher Education GAA Club;

Students who have received an award from the Ulster GAA Student Bursary Scheme in the past are ineligible to apply for a second award.

Senior Inter-County players, who are members of the GPA, should apply to the GPA Scheme only.

The closing date for applications will be Friday 11th October 2019
