Relative to Motion 24, the following Directive is issued by Central Council to Competitions Control Committees (under Rule 3.43(b)):

If a transfer request cites child safeguarding as one of the grounds for the request, that ground should only be considered if there has been a prior complaint in relation to child safeguarding to a Children's Officer – Club, County, Provincial or National. Where such a complaint has been made, the CCC considering the transfer request shall obtain a report of any investigation carried out by the relevant Children's Officer before considering the Transfer request. If there has been no complaint or investigation, then the Transfer request should be adjudicated upon without reference to child safeguarding.
